We will then proceed to OR Tambo International Airport for check-in and our flight to Windhoek, Namibia.



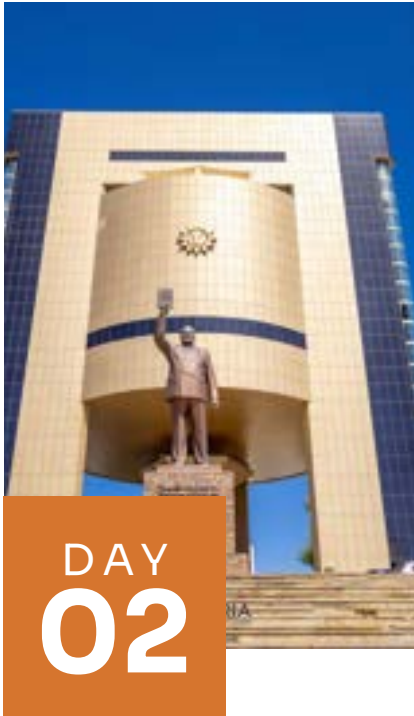

DAY 3: WINDHOEK – SOSSUSVLEI

29th November 2026

DAY

Breakfast will be served from 7:00 AM.

We will check out and depart the hotel exactly at 8:00 AM for a brief tour of Windhoek city. This will also be the best opportunity for shopping, as we will be heading into more remote areas where shopping facilities are limited.

During the city tour, we will visit some of Windhoek's iconic landmarks and gain a final introduction to Namibia's capital before continuing our journey south.

We aim to depart Windhoek by approximately 9:30 AM and begin our drive to Sossusvlei.

Approximate Driving Time: 5–6 hours, excluding comfort stops.

This will mainly be a travel day, allowing us to experience Namibia's vast landscapes and changing scenery.

The first section of the journey is on a tarmac road, while the latter section is on well-maintained gravel roads. Although the roads are in good condition, the drive can be dusty at times, which is part of the authentic Namibian desert experience.

Along the way, we will make a stop at the famous Pink Fridge, one of Namibia's most unique roadside attractions and a perfect photo opportunity.

Upon arrival at AGAMA Lodge, guests will have time to relax and enjoy the facilities. Those interested can take a swim, unwind, or simply enjoy the tranquility of the desert surroundings.

Dinner will be served from 7:00 PM, after which guests are free to rest at their leisure.

As we will have an early start the following morning for our Sossusvlei excursion, we recommend an early night to ensure everyone is well rested for the adventure ahead.

BIG DADDY DUNE & DEADVLEI EXPERIENCE

30th November 2026

DAY
04

Today will be our earliest start of the trip.

We will wake up at 4:30 AM and be served with tea, coffee, and light snacks such as biscuits and cake before departure. Our main breakfast will be packed for later in the morning.

The reason for the early departure is that our lodge is located approximately one hour from the Sossusvlei entrance gate. In addition, Sossusvlei is one of Namibia's most visited attractions and often experiences long queues at the entrance. Leaving early allows us to avoid the crowds, enter the park among the first visitors, and enjoy a more relaxed experience.

Our destination today is the famous Big Daddy Dune and Deadvlei, two of Namibia's most iconic attractions. As we drive through the dunes, guests will have two options for the excursion.

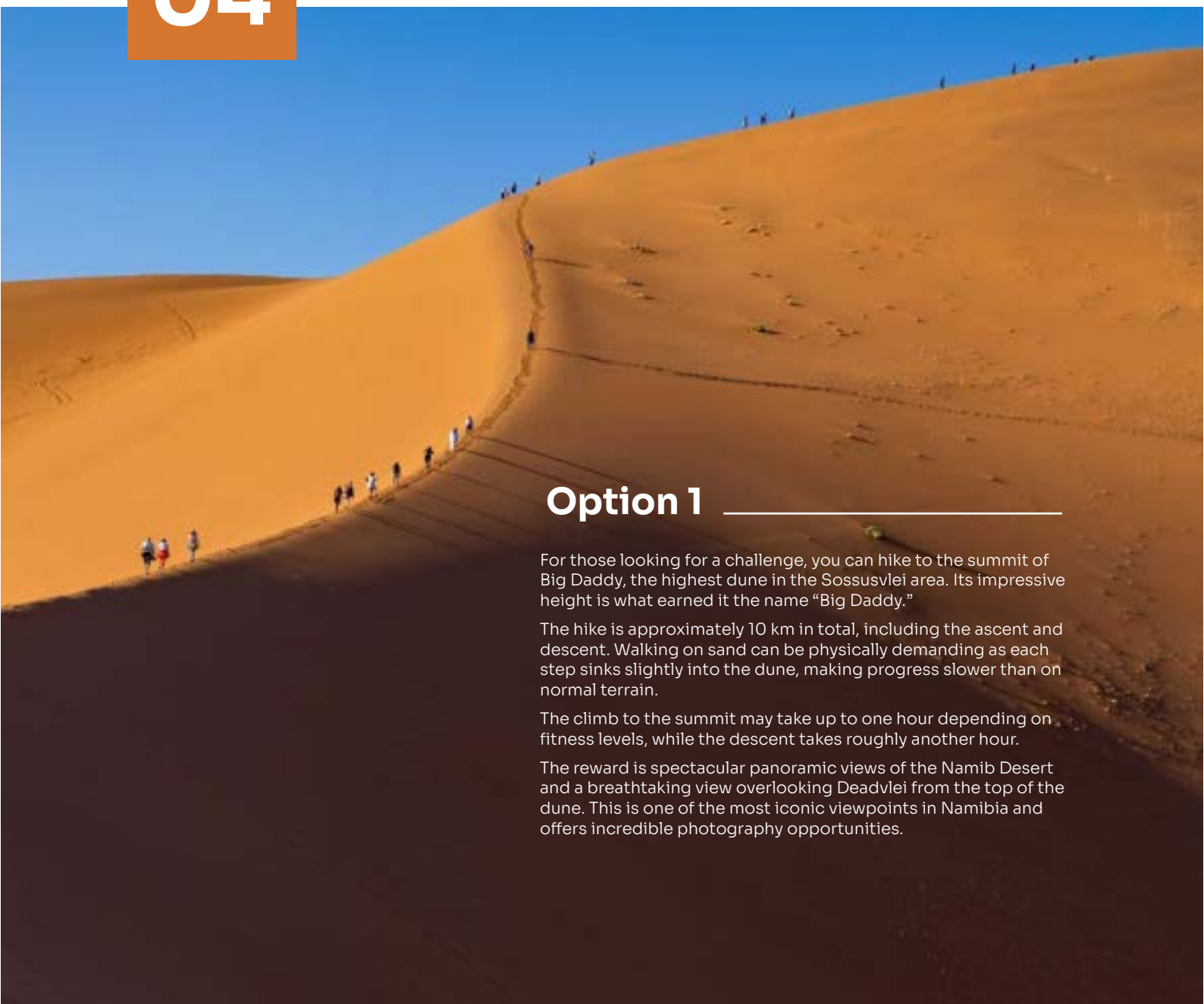
Option 1

For those looking for a challenge, you can hike to the summit of Big Daddy, the highest dune in the Sossusvlei area. Its impressive height is what earned it the name "Big Daddy."

The hike is approximately 10 km in total, including the ascent and descent. Walking on sand can be physically demanding as each step sinks slightly into the dune, making progress slower than on normal terrain.

The climb to the summit may take up to one hour depending on fitness levels, while the descent takes roughly another hour.

The reward is spectacular panoramic views of the Namib Desert and a breathtaking view overlooking Deadvlei from the top of the dune. This is one of the most iconic viewpoints in Namibia and offers incredible photography opportunities.

BIG DADDY DUNE & DEADVLEI EXPERIENCE

30th November 2026

OPTION 2: DIRECT WALK TO DEADVLEI

Guests who prefer a less strenuous experience may skip the Big Daddy climb and walk directly to Deadvlei.

This walk is approximately 1.5 km from the vehicle drop-off point and provides access to the famous white clay pan dotted with ancient camel thorn trees. Deadvlei is one of Namibia's most photographed landscapes and offers incredible opportunities for photography and exploration without the challenge of the dune climb.

After the excursion and photography sessions, we will make a short refreshment stop before beginning our journey back to the lodge.

We expect to return to the hotel by approximately 3:00 PM, giving everyone time to relax, enjoy the swimming pool, take a nap, or simply unwind after the morning's adventure.

Dinner will be served from 7:00 PM, after which guests can rest and prepare for the next day's journey.



SOSSUSVLEI – SOLITAIRE – LANGSTRAND

1st December 2026

Breakfast will be served from 7:00 AM.

We will check out and depart the lodge exactly at 8:00 AM as we begin our journey towards Namibia's Atlantic coastline.

Approximate Driving Time:

6–7 hours, excluding comfort stops and activities.

Today's drive will once again showcase Namibia's vast and ever-changing landscapes. The first section of the journey will be on well-maintained gravel roads, which can be dusty at times, before eventually joining the tarmac road as we approach the coast.

Along the way, we will make a stop at Solitaire, a small desert settlement that has become one of Namibia's most famous stopover points. Known for its vintage vehicles, historic buildings, old church, and unique desert charm, Solitaire offers a glimpse into Namibia's pioneering past and provides a great opportunity for photographs.

SOSSUSVLEI – SOLITAIRE – LANGSTRAND

1st December 2026

After our stop, we will continue westwards towards the Atlantic coastline.

We expect to arrive at the coast from approximately 2:00 PM onwards.

Our first stop on the coast will be Walvis Bay, Namibia's main port town and industrial harbour. This is where much of the country's shipping and fishing activity takes place and serves as the gateway to many of the coastal adventures Namibia is known for.

From Walvis Bay, we will proceed directly for our quad biking experience in the Namib Desert. This exciting adventure offers the chance to ride across the desert landscape and experience the dunes from a completely different perspective.

Following the quad biking excursion, we will continue to Langstrand and check into Bay View Resort Namibia.

The remainder of the afternoon and evening will be at leisure. Guests can relax at the hotel, enjoy the swimming pool, take a stroll along the beach, or simply unwind while taking in the views of the Atlantic Ocean.

Please note that the coastal region is significantly cooler than the desert areas we have visited, as it lies along the Atlantic Ocean. A light jacket or warm layer is highly recommended, especially during the evenings and early mornings.

Dinner will be served at the hotel, after which guests are free to relax and enjoy the rest of the evening in preparation for the next day's adventures.
